Vesper Liturgy — 6:00pm (7 November - Wednesday)

**Reminder:** In preparation for receiving Holy Communion at the Vesper Liturgy, fasting should begin no later than noon that day!



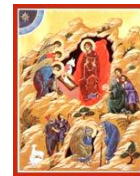
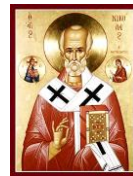
### Entry of the Most-Holy Theotokos into the Temple (21 Nov):

Divine Liturgy — 9:00am (21 November - Wednesday)

## November Liturgical News & Notes:

- ◆ Daylight Savings Time ends on Sunday November 4<sup>th</sup> (2:00am). Don't forget to set your clocks back one hour before going to bed on Saturday November 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- ◆ We will celebrate the Vesper Liturgy on the eve of the Feast of the Synaxis of the Archangel Michael and the Other Bodiless Powers (Nov 7th). In preparation for receiving Holy Communion at this Vesper Liturgy, fasting should begin no later than noon that day!
- ◆ The Nativity (St. Philip's) Fast begins on Thursday November 15<sup>th</sup> and concludes on the Feast of the Nativity of Our Lord on Tuesday December 25<sup>th</sup>.
- ◆ On November 10<sup>th</sup> we will return to our winter schedule with Saturday Great Vespers beginning at 4:00pm!
