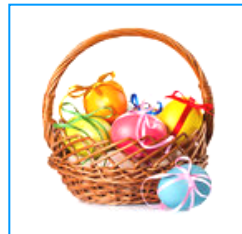

St. Tikhon's Seminary Choir

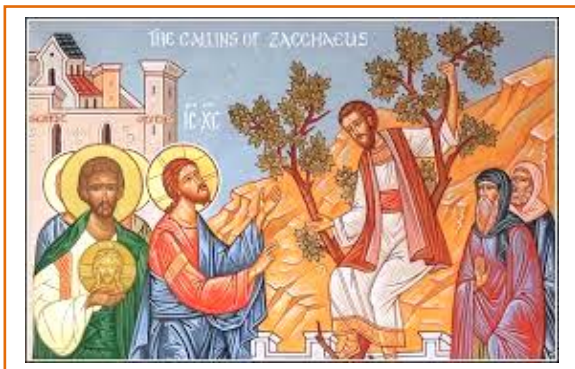


The St. Tikhon's Seminary Mission Choir will be visiting our parish the weekend of March 2nd-3rd. In anticipation of this visit a basket will be

Sunday of Zacchaeus



We often find in the Gospels the encouragement to approach God: *"Ask, and you will receive, knock and the door will be opened..."* In Revelation, however, we are reminded that God loves us so much, he is constantly calling us to come to him. But how can we feel God's gentle nudge or hear his quieting words if we don't take a moment out from our hectic days for that purpose? Can we hear God over the stereo, office chatter or clanging dishes?

Like the tax collector Zacchaeus who climbed a tree in order to see Jesus above the heads of the crowd, we need to make a special effort to hear and feel the presence of God. Zacchaeus could have stayed home that day, or he could have just remained standing with the spectators, but he put out special effort and was rewarded for doing so.

In our busy days, it takes special effort to find a few quiet moments to spend with Jesus, who is constantly at our side, knocking at our door. We must take the time to open the door and let him into our lives.
