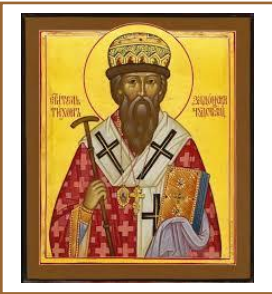

St. Symeon the New Theologian

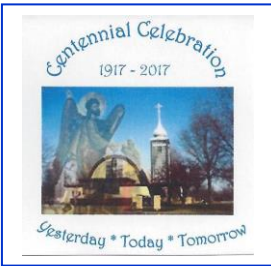
St. Tikhon, Bishop of Voronezh, Wonderworker of Zadonsk and All Russia



Timothy, as he was baptized, was from a poor family in eighteenth-century Novgorod. He went to the seminary at a young age and later taught Greek and other subjects there. He was tonsured a monk and given the name Tikhon. That same year he was ordained to the diaconate and to the priesthood. Shortly afterwards he was named rector of a seminary, and again shortly thereafter he was named Bishop of Voronezh. However, because of the size of the diocese, its transient population and many schismatics, Tikhon felt this to be an unmanageable situation. He resigned and went to the Monastery of Tolshevo and later to Zadonsk. He prayed and wrote books there until he died at the age of fifty-nine. As a result of his literary endeavors he has become known as the Russian Chrysostom. He wrote in a simple style, mostly of the duties of Christians, with quotes from Holy Scripture. He teaches how to oppose the passions and cultivate the virtues. Sixty years after he was buried, it was necessary to move his body because a new church was being built to replace the old one. Tikhon's body and his vestments were found incorrupt in this damp place. Many miracles have occurred because of the prayers of Saint Tikhon. Three hundred thousand people attended when this beloved Russian saint was canonized in 1863. People often pray to Saint Tikhon for the protection and upbringing of their children.
