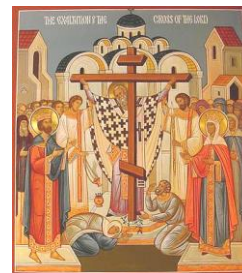
The Universal Exaltation (Elevation) of the Precious and Life-Giving Cross

“However much every action or manifestation of Christ is magnificent, divine, and extraordinary, none of them is so worthy of admiration as the Cross, which is in itself worthy of all veneration. Nor in fact was death destroyed by anything other than the Cross of our Lord Jesus Christ.... Beatitude House School Supplies Drive

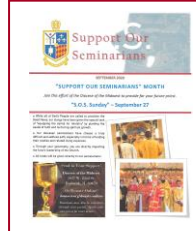
