“ the evening and the morning were the first day.”

In Orthodoxy we adhere to the Scriptural method of marking the days as "**the evening and the morning**" (Genesis 1:5), and therefore the Sunday celebration of the Resurrection begins with Vespers on Saturday evening, and all the Great Feasts similarly begin on the evening before the appointed day.

We should always try to attend the Vespers or Vigil on the evening before a Sunday or Holy Day, especially if we are planning to receive the Holy Mysteries of Holy Communion at the Divine Liturgy that day. Attendance at Vespers is an essential part of our preparation for the worthy and beneficial reception of Holy Communion.

If because of infirmity, having to travel a great distance to church, or some other cause we are unable to attend the Saturday evening services or those on the Eve of Great Holy Days, we should at the very least spend the time at home in quiet, in spiritual reading, in reading the service which is being chanted in church, or in prayer.

Orthodox Christians do not entertain, socialize or enjoy amusements or diversions on these evenings which are part of a day that is holy unto the Lord.
